- 6.5 Million children immunized from polio under special immunisation campaign to eliminate polio on 1st phase.

- 3.7 million children under five were administered vitamin 'A' capsules in 75 districts.

- 63 children are suffered by communicable diseases like, diarrhea, vomiting and fever in different districts of Nepal & 13was died. (6 cases reported by CH)

- 13 Children died from food poison. (5boys & 8 girls)

- 84 Children sick from food poison. (15 girls, 10 boys & 58 unid) (4 cases reported by CH)

- 3 Children died from cold. (3 boys)

- 6 Children sick from cold. (1girls & 3 boys, 2 unidentified) (4 cases reported by CH)

- 5 Children died from unknown disease. (5boys)

- 154Children sick from unknown disease.(28 boys, 26 girls& 100unid)(29 cases reported by CH)

Of 361 reported rape cases 30.47% were of under 18 & 17.45% minors cases were of children below 10 years, youngest being 1 year old. 1.66% was murdered after rape. 8.31% cases were of gang rape. 47.92% cases were of Individual rape. 5.54% cases were of incest rape. Culprits were arrested in only 214 cases.
